



TUTORIAL – USING EMBROIDERY GLITTER or REFLECTRA STITCHFOIL SCRAPS

If you like using Embroidery glitter or Reflectra Stitchfoil, you are going to have scraps! I save every little bit. This Tutorial shows you how to make *fabric* for shashing on a wall hanging, around a picture or as stripes on a pillow.

1. Cut a piece of fabric a little larger all around than you want your finished piece. For fabric you can use all kinds – solids, prints, batiks, stripes.
2. Cut various shapes out of your scraps. Strips, triangles, circles, squares or odd shapes. Another great option is to use a paper punch. They come in all sizes and shapes now! I only have a regular circle punch – I can see I will have to go shopping☺
3. Place your fabric on your ironing board.
4. Place your pieces on your fabric. You can be very precise and measure between everything or just put them on randomly. I opted for the random method for my samples.
5. Cover with a Teflon pressing cloth and press at high heat for 15 – 20 seconds. Here are some I came up with:





Trim your fabric to size:

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Now you can use your fabric in your project! If you need to press the fabric with the glitter on it, be sure to use a Teflon pressing cloth.
